

### PEOPLE USE THESE TRAILS EVERY DAY























#### Key



- Direct Highway Access The site is located off an I-84 exit, westbound to the Portland Metro Region and eastbound to the Columbia River Gorge
- Downtown Troutdale The site is in close proximity to downtown Troutdale, well known for its charming small town aesthetic, shops, and restaurants
- **Owned by the City -** The site is owned by the City of Troutdale and falls within an Urban Renewal Area, which also includes the adjacent Columbia Gorge Outlets
