








East Multnomah County Safe Routes to School Grants July 2017 - June 2026



What is Safe Routes to School?

SRTS refers to a national program that improves, educates, and encourages children to walk and bike/roll to school. Efforts include:

- Transportation Safety lessons
 - Pedestrian Safety
 - Bicycle Safety
 - Personal Safety
- Community Outreach/Events
- Walk+Roll to School Events
- Circulation Support
- Coordinating with 3 school districts and East County jurisdictions
