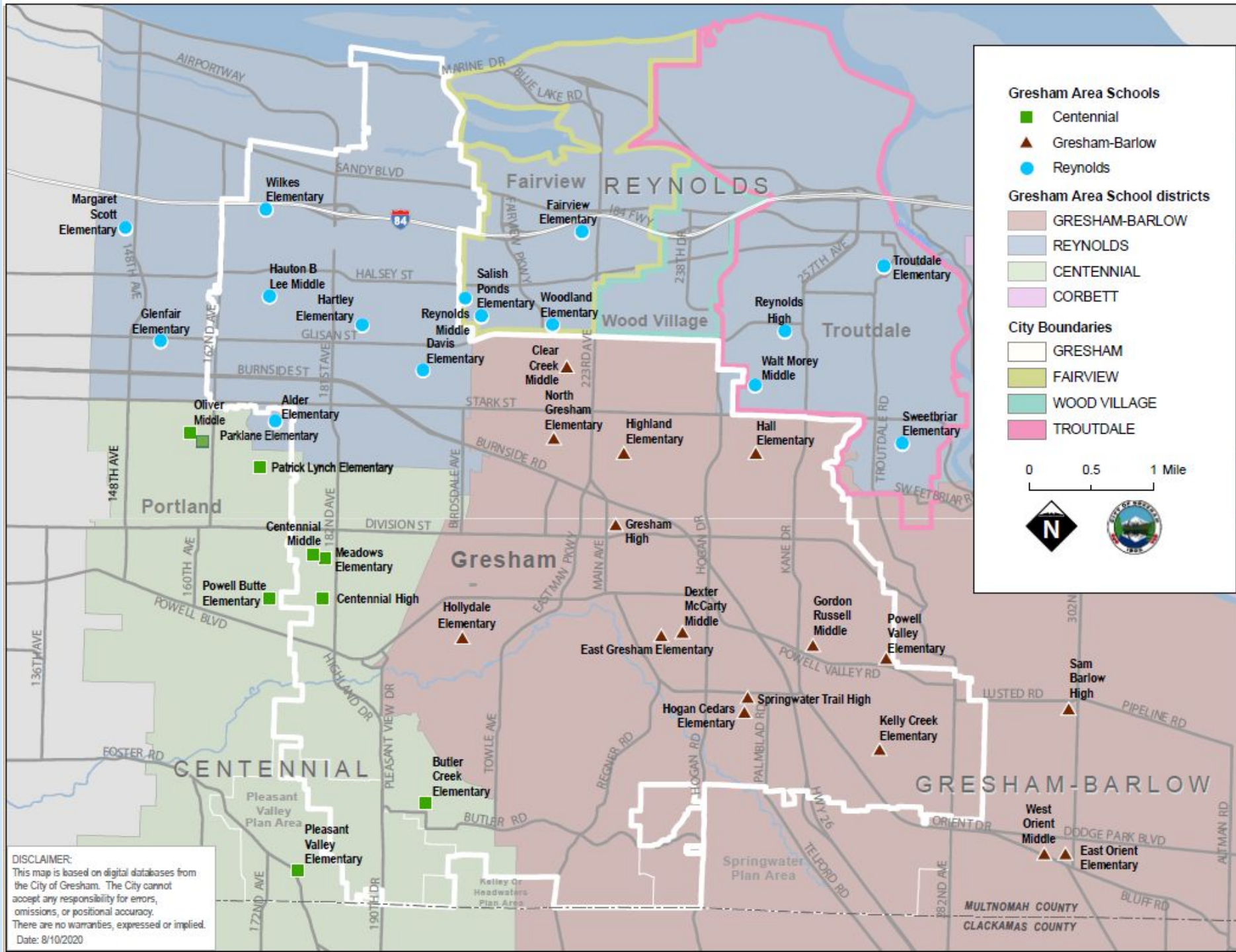

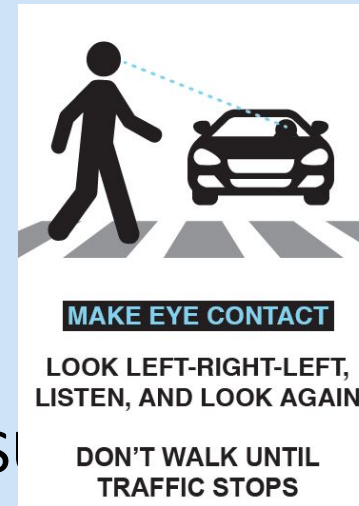
Education

Pedestrian Safety Lessons

- SRTS Program staff teach 30 minute lessons in S after school or PE classes
- Working with Districts to teach the curriculum, known as “Train the Trainer.”

Bike Rodeos, Traffic Playgrounds

Outreach in East County

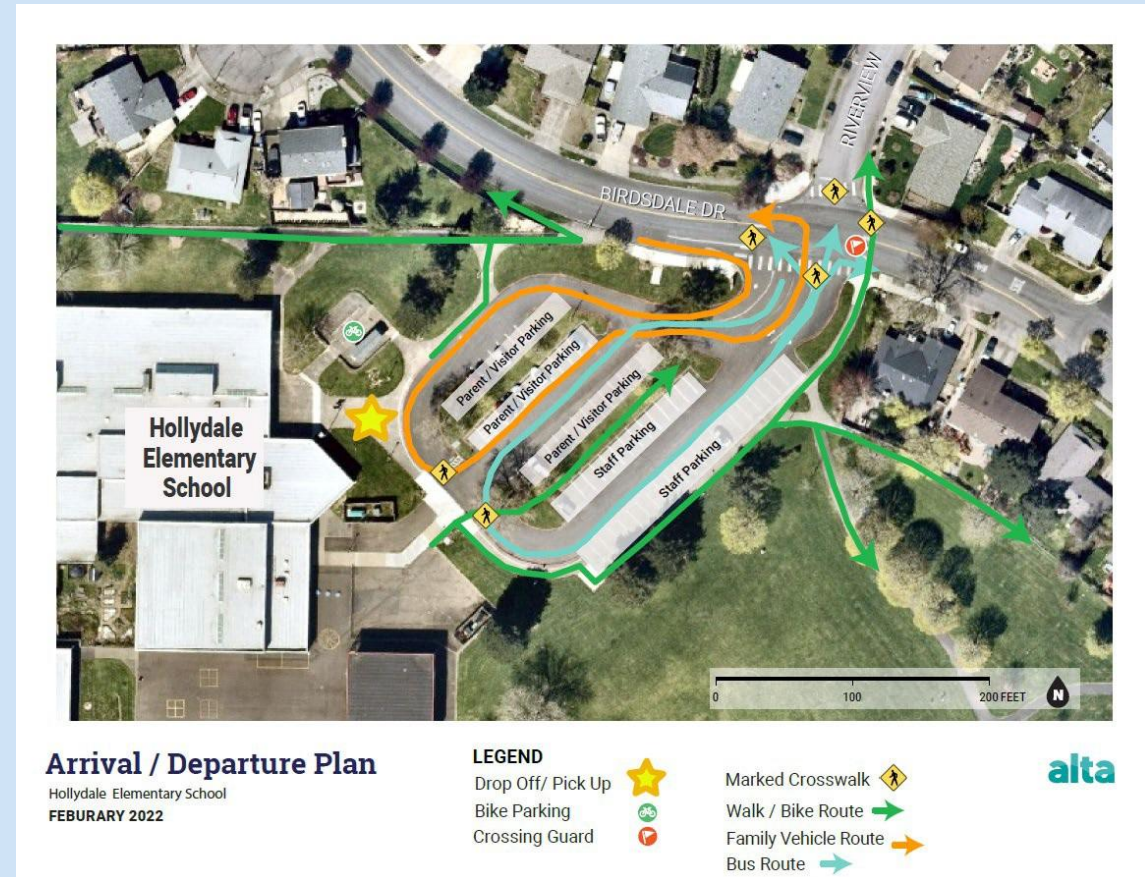
Tabling at many east county events
