CHIEF JUSTICE ORDER & PRESIDING RELEASE ORDER

- HB4002 Required Chief Justice to evaluate release guidelines for persons charged with distribution or manufacturing drug cases.
- Revised Chief Justice Order May 2024
- Chief Justice Order sets the release guidelines for every charge.
 Release Guidelines 1, 2 or 3
 - I. Release on Own Recognizance
 - 2. Release with Conditions,
 - 3. Hold for Arraignment
- Presiding Judges directed to revise current Pretrial Release Orders

PRESIDING RELEASE ORDER REVISIONS

- Highlights
 - Any person charged with Distribution or Manufacture of Fentanyl will be held for arraignment
 - Any person charged with Substantial quantities or commercial drug offenses will be held for arraignment.
 - Person booked on a UUMV, PSMV, Burglary 2 and has at least one prior conviction in the last 3 years shall be held.
 - Person making clear and unequivocal threat to cause harm to a named victim shall be held.

PRESIDING RELEASE ORDER REVISIONS

- Highlights Failure to Appear
 - Person booked into custody and have 5 or more historical failures to appear within the last 3 years
 - Person is booked into custody on a failure to appear warrant on a pending felony or person misdemeanor. Except if they are unrepresented.
 - Unrepresented person is booked on a failure to appear warrant. Having failed to appear two or more times on separate dates
 - Person is booked into custody on a failure to appear warrant on a non person misdemeanor having had two or more FTA's in the pending case.
