Declaring March 2020 as Purchasing Month in Multnomah County, Oregon.

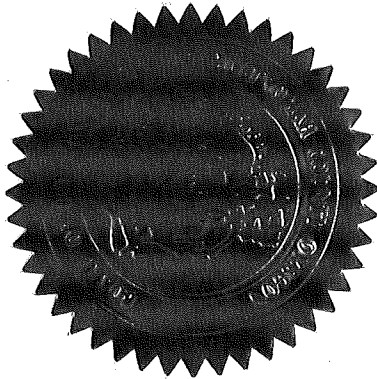
The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:
