Proclaiming the First Friday in July as Data Professionals Appreciation Day in Multnomah County, Oregon.



Multnomah County Finds:



- A. Data Professionals provide the data analysis and outcome-focused reporting essential to telling the story of the work we do in Multnomah County every day.
