Proclaiming April 30, 2025 as Therapy Animal Day In Multnomah County, Oregon.

- A. There are thousands of Pet Partners therapy animal teams serving in communities across the United States.

- C. Scientific research shows that interacting with therapy animals can reduce stress, relieve depression, slow heart rate, lower blood pressure and strengthen the immune system.
- D. Therapy animal teams in Multnomah County play an essential role in improving human health and well-being through the human-animal bond.
- E. Therapy animal teams interact with a variety of people in our community including veterans, older adults, patients in a variety of healthcare settings, students, and those approaching the end of life.
- F. These exceptional therapy animals who partner with their human companions bring comfort and healing to those in need.
- G. We encourage more pet owners to consider becoming Pet Partners volunteers to help our community by creating greater access to meaningful therapy animal visits.
