**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-003**

Approving a New Lease of the Property Located at 1808 SE Belmont Street, Portland, Oregon 97214 for the EASA Behavioral Health Division.

**The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:**

- a. A lease of premises within the property located at 1808 SE Belmont Street, Portland, Oregon 97214 (“Lease”) will provide the EASA (Early Assessment and Support Alliance) program in the Behavioral Health Division with appropriate space necessary for their office and client space needs.
- b. This Lease would create a permanent and centralized space for youth, young adults and families who are receiving services from the Multnomah County’s Behavioral Health Division’s Early Assessment and Support Alliance (EASA) program. This program provides assessment, early intervention, related mental health services, and employment assistance in the beginning years of onset of psychosis. The EASA program is client-facing with mental health services including Individual and Family Therapy, Family Training, Consultation, Occupational Therapy, Psychiatric Medication Management, Nursing, Peer Support Services, Supported Employment Services, Case Management, and Psychiatric Medication Administration. EASA is a specialized program that serves individuals who have their first onset of psychosis between the ages of 12-25 years of age.
- c. Approval of the Lease in substantial conformance with the proposed terms is in the best interests of Multnomah County.

**The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:**

1. The County Chair is authorized to execute a lease in substantial conformance with the terms proposed.
2. The County Chair is authorized to execute renewals, extensions and amendments of the Lease and any ancillary instruments without further Board action.
