RESOLUTION NO. 2022-107

Approving Extension of the Room-Block Agreement at the Hotel Located at 3801 N. Interstate Avenue, Portland, Oregon

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The use of emergency shelter is one of many approaches employed by the Joint Office of Homeless Services (JOHS) to address homelessness and related issues.
- b. Extending the agreement to rent all of the transient lodging units at the hotel located at 3801 N. Interstate Avenue, Portland, OR ("Room-Block Agreement"), will continue to provide 43 emergency shelter units in the JOHS portfolio, 4 rooms of program space, and as part of Multnomah County's homeless services response to the Covid-19 pandemic, will serve individuals assessed to be at high-risk of negative health outcomes related to Covid-19.
- c. Approval of the Room-Block Agreement extension in substantial conformance with the proposed terms is in the best interests of Multnomah County.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

- 1. Extension of the Room-Block Agreement on terms substantially similar to those proposed is approved.
- 2. Renewals, extensions and amendments may be executed without further Board action.
