RESOLUTION NO. 2022-007

Filling a Vacancy in the Legislative Assembly, Oregon House of Representatives, District 44.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Effective January 21st, 2022 there is a vacancy in Oregon State House, District 44, due to the resignation of Representative Tina Kotek.
- b. Pursuant to state law, the Democratic Party Precinct Committeepersons of House District 44 met to choose nominees to fill the vacancy.
- c. The nominees chosen were: Travis Nelson, Eric Delehoj, Rita Moore, and Marc Koller.
- d. In accordance with procedures established by the Secretary of State, the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners considered the nominations at a regular board meeting at 9:30 AM on January, 27th, 2022.
- e. At the conclusion of the public meeting the Commissioners voted to appoint Travis Nelson to fill the vacancy, said nominee having received the highest number of votes as indicated on the vote tabulation attached as Exhibit A.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

- 1. Travis Nelson is selected as the appointee to fill the vacancy in the Oregon House of Representatives, District 44.
- 2. This Resolution shall promptly be forwarded to the Secretary of State as required by ORS 171.060(3).
