- June 3, 2025 at noon: Applicant's final argument; final argument must be based on information in the record
 - June 6, 2025 at noon deadline for objections to inclusion of new evidence in final argument

• June 25, 2025: Hearings Officer's Decision

If objections are filed, I will endeavor to issue an Order responding to the objection promptly. My response to objections to the applicant's final argument will be included in my decision.
