**Riverdale School District #51J**

**26-75 Five-Year Local Option Tax For District Operations**

**Question:** Shall the District levy \$1.07 per \$1000 of assessed value each year for five years beginning 2006-2007 for operations?

**Summary:** This measure may be passed only at an election with at least a 50 percent voter turnout. This measure authorizes Riverdale School District No. 51J, Multnomah and Clackamas Counties, Oregon, to levy a property tax in the amount of \$1.07 per \$1000 of assessed value each year for five years. The taxes would be used to help finance District operations. Without the additional revenue, the District will have to reduce staff and services.

An estimate of the total amount to be raised each fiscal year is: \$460,000 in 2006-2007; \$460,000 in 2007-2008; \$460,000 in 2008-2009; \$460,000 in 2009-2010; and \$460,000 in 2010-2011.
