



## **SAFETY PRIORITY BRIEF: SEPTEMBER 2008**













**Notes:** Average Daily Reported Offenses, after declining from July to August increased 9% to 107 per day. This change was primarily from increases in Theft and Auto Theft crimes. Average Daily Arrests decreased 3% from the previous month with a continued decline in all other categories except for Other. Average Daily Population increased for the first time since April; increasing the utilization rate to 95.3 %.









**Notes:** District Attorney Average Daily Received Cases, continued the trend of increases and decreases, increasing 22% from August to September, to 87. This was its highest level since December 2006. Average Daily Adult Court Outcome and Juvenile probation caseloads continue to rise. The biggest increase was in Primary Conviction in the categories of Behavioral and Vehicle/ DUI categories.
