- ✓ Include alternate text/image descriptions

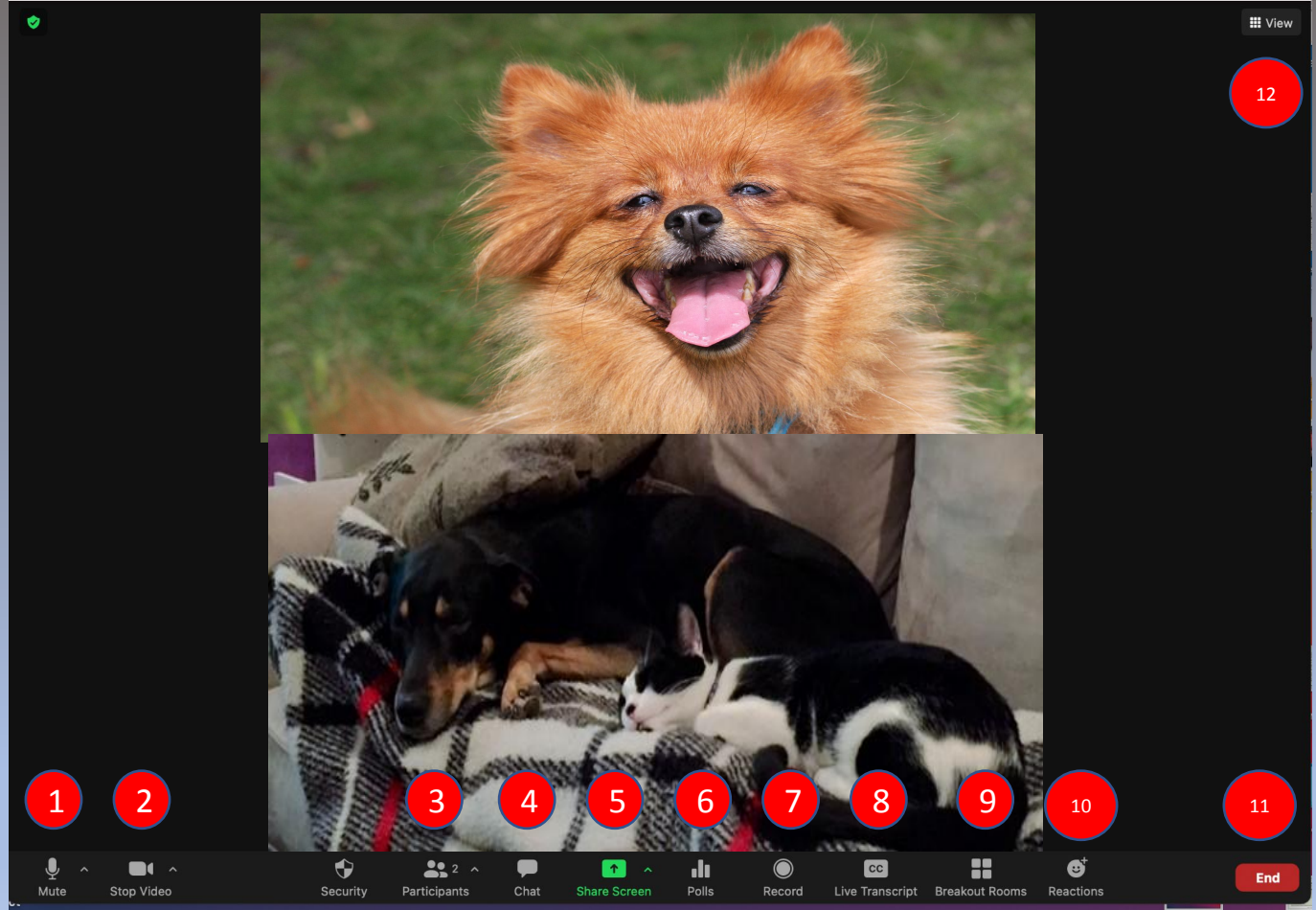
Accessibility Statement

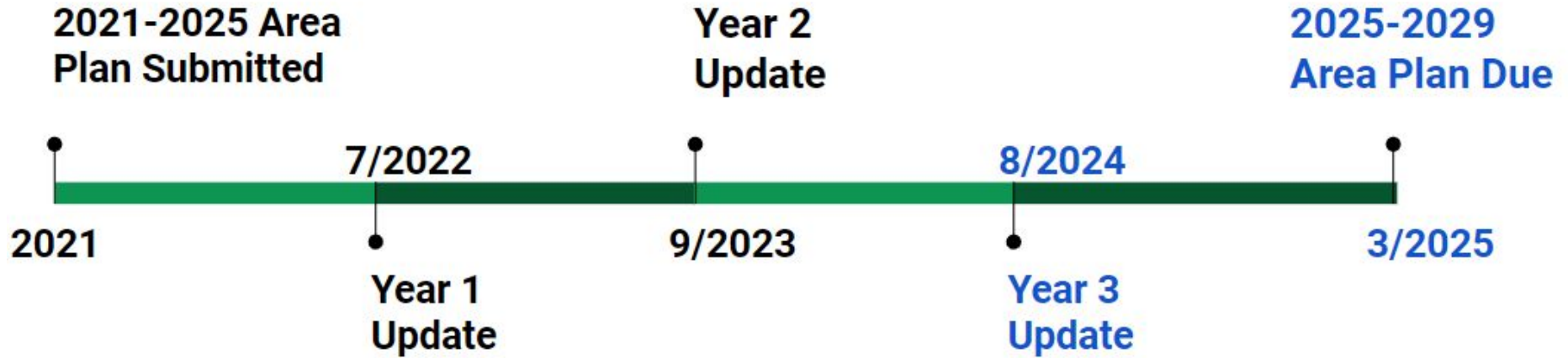

ADVSD Area Plan

What is the Area Plan?

- Formally called the Area Agency on Aging Area Plan
- 4 Year Plan for Older Americans Act (OAA) Programs
- The Area Plan describes how the ADVSD will provide a comprehensive and coordinated delivery system to older adults in our community
- Required by the State



ADVSD Area Plan

What is in the Area Plan?

- Includes 6 overarching focus areas (listed on the next slide) with measurable objectives for each goal
- There is a separate service equity plan for ADVSD that will be incorporated into the upcoming area plan
- Plan includes a budget attachment for projected expenses and count of people served



ADVSD Area Plan

Required Focus Areas

- Information and Referral Services and ADRC
- Nutrition Services
- Health Promotion
- Family and Unpaid Caregiver Support
- Legal Assistance and Elder Rights Protection Activities
- Older Native Americans

Other focus areas may be added.

- New Appendix, which is a final report on the AAA's Service Equity Plan
- Accomplishments achieved as a result of service equity efforts
- Budget workbook (revised)



ADVSD Area Plan

Priority Communities for 2025:

Describe how ADVSD will identify and provide services to older individuals who have greatest economic and social need, with particular attention to:

- Low-income older individuals:
 - Minority individuals
 - Individuals with limited English proficiency
 - Individuals residing in rural areas
- Older individuals at risk for institutional placement
- Older individuals who are Native American
- Social need includes issues related to (LGBTQIA2S+) individuals

2025-2029 Area Plan Overarching Questions (still in development)

- What is working well regarding [area plan focus area]
- What do you need more of regarding [area plan focus area]
