The following priorities will guide me during the next two years:

Public Safety – Public Safety continues to be a top priority for me.

Fairview approved a contract with Multnomah County in 2018 to provide police services. This eliminated the former Fairview Police Department. My priority will be to make certain the service level for police services in the agreement is fulfilled. It's important for our community members to see active patrols in our neighborhoods.

I would like to see more residents take advantage of a little known sidewalk program that assists property owners to repair sidewalks in the public right of way. This would make it much safer, especially for our senior and disabled members of the community.

Financial Health of the City – I will continue to support periodic utility rate reviews that minimize rate increases while supporting infrastructure that is way beyond its intended life cycle.

I will support cooperation between the cities in close proximity to Fairview. We can build solid relationships with our neighboring cities. There are potential economies of scale if we all work together. We should openly discuss ways to more efficiently deliver services to our communities. The need for city services has never been greater.

Economic Development – I'm excited about the possibilities of improving the Halsey corridor with expanded development that will ultimately provide additional funding to support the general fund. Expanded development activities will support public safety, parks and infrastructure improvements.

I support continued efforts to building a stronger sense of community. I look forward to your suggestions and encourage you to consider taking an active role in your community as your personal time allows.
