The following priorities will guide me during the next two years:

Public Safety – Public Safety continues to be a top priority for me. I am proud of the dedicated police force in our city and commend them for maintaining voluntary accreditation established by the Oregon Accreditation Alliance.

The Multnomah County Sheriff has offered to provide police services to the City of Fairview. This will require careful consideration to ensure service levels remain the same or better while maintaining our short-term and long-term financial goals.

Parks and Community Fun – I am excited to see and support the major park improvements in process at Park Cleone and Fairview Woods. Updating these parks will provide the community with additional recreational opportunities.

I applaud the grassroots non-profits who have formed to provide additional volunteer services by adopting roads and streams throughout the city, sponsoring community town halls and joining the Citizens on Patrol Program.

Public Works – I will continue to support periodic utility rate reviews that minimize rate increases while supporting infrastructure that is way beyond its intended life cycle.

Economic Development – I support immediate Council action to implement financing programs that target vacant properties and previously occupied storefronts. I encourage Developers that want to build and develop in Fairview bringing with them fresh ideas.

The City of Fairview is primarily residential and will benefit by additional services closer to our homes and help sustain our tax base. This will support public safety, parks and infrastructure improvements.

I look forward to your suggestions and encourage you to consider taking an active role in your community as your personal time allows.
