The Earthquake Ready Burnside Bridge Project



Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement available for public review and input through June 13, 2022.

In 2021, the project team published a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) that identified a recommended Preferred Alternative as part of the federally required National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process. Since then, after gathering community input, project leaders approved several refinements to the Preferred Alternative that reduce overall project costs to help ensure the project is more likely to be funded and built. The Supplemental Draft EIS documents the changes to the original Preferred Alternative from the Draft EIS.

Your comments will help the project team update the Supplemental Draft EIS before submitting the Final EIS for approval in December 2022.
