Newly Diagnosed Demographic Snapshot

- **92** Newly Diagnosed clients joined the RW Care System in 2023
 - **79%** of clients were Male, **14%** Female, **5%** Transgender
 - **64%** were BIPOC
 - **20%** were <25 years, **54%** 25-44 years, **25%** 45-64 years
 - 76% from Multnomah, 9% from Clackamas, 9% from Washington,
 7% from Clack WA
 - 62% had MSM exposure, 24% Hetero, 10% Other, 4% IDU
 - **66%** had Medicaid, **4%** had no insurance
 - **32%** were in temporary or unstable housing situations
 - **53%** had no source of income
