

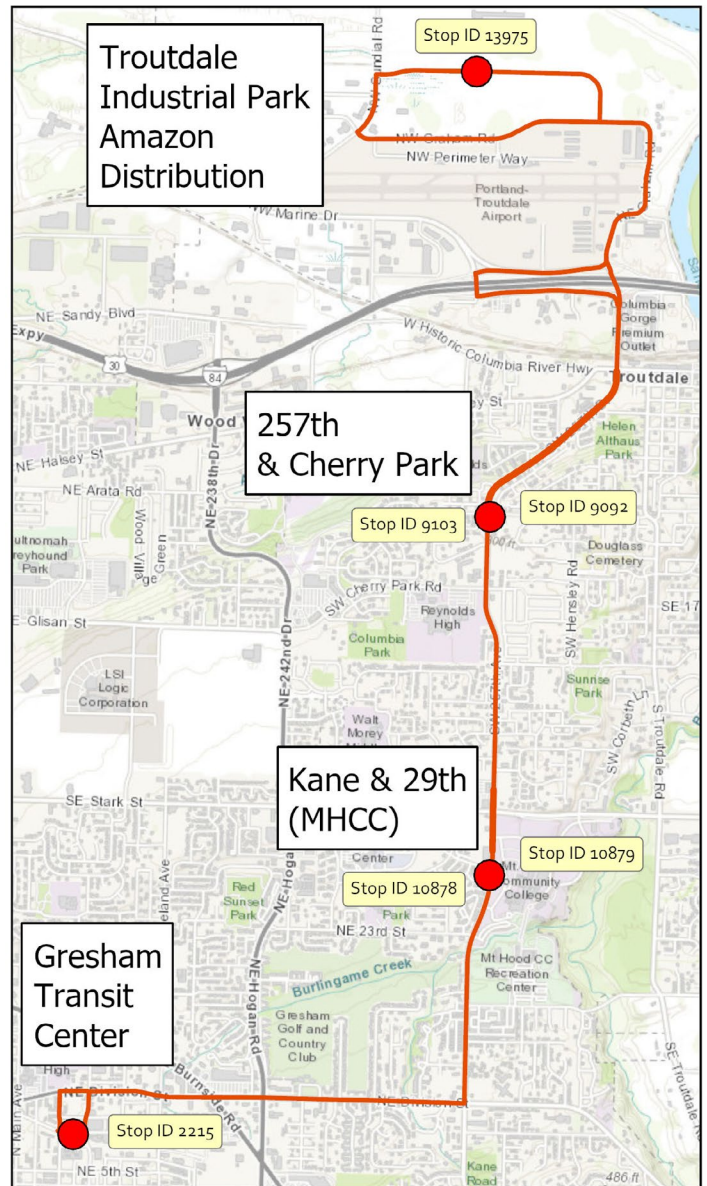
JOB CONNECT SHUTTLE SERVICE

Multnomah County is offering a free shuttle service to the Troutdale Reynolds Industrial Park area on weekends and holidays.

Following TriMet's line 81 route, the shuttle runs during the AM/PM peak hours on Saturdays and Sundays, and holidays, between the Gresham Transit Center and the Industrial Park with two stops in between. **For drop off**, make a request to the driver upon boarding.

Operated with a grant from TriMet, Multnomah County is contracting with ecoShuttle for this service. If the scheduled shuttle is more than 15 minutes late, feel free to call 503-548-4480 x0 for an update.
