CLEVELAND AVE TO POWELL BLVD

Traffic volumes on Burnside Rd range from 26,000 vehicles per day near Cleveland Ave to 37,000 near Powell Blvd. The posted speed limit is 35 mph. The corridor has seen a high number of crashes, including pedestrian crashes, rear-end, and angle crashes.

Community members have shared concerns about speeding and reported feeling unsafe walking and biking, especially near Hogan Dr and Burnside Rd Pedestrians often face challenges with drivers not yielding at intersections, and there is a general lack of safe crossing options along the corridor.
