POWELL BLVD TO SPRINGWATER CORRIDOR TRAIL

Hogan Rd, between Powell Blvd and the Springwater Corridor Trail, carries 15,000 to 18,000 vehicles per day. This stretch has a high number of crashes, mostly rear-end crashes, with some angle crashes. Although the posted speed limit is 35 mph, our speed analysis shows many drivers are driving faster.

Community members have expressed feeling unsafe walking and biking, particularly at the Springwater Trail crossing. There are also gaps in the sidewalk network and a lack of ADA-compliant curb ramps, making access difficult for many users. Future plans to widen the road could lead to more traffic and encourage even faster driving.
