UNOFFICIAL BALLOT BOXES IN OREGON

(ORS 260.695)

Oregon Law allows anyone to collect ballots. However, the law requires that anyone collecting ballots must clearly show the language below on the collection box and that anyone returning a ballot for someone else must do so no later than two days after receiving the ballot or by 8 p.m. on election day. Oregon Law requires that the lettering on the unofficial drop box be at least <u>50 point bold font</u> <u>size and in all caps</u>. The following is the official text and a sample of the minimum size using 50 point bold Arial font.

NOT AN OFFICIAL BALLOT DROP SITE

Election officials discourage voters from using unofficial drop sites.

How to return your ballot in Oregon:

By mail: Vote early and return your ballot by mail. No stamp needed! Get your ballot in the mail on or before Election Day to ensure it is received by our office on time.

In person at an Official Ballot Drop Site: Deliver the signed and sealed ballot return envelope to any Official Ballot Drop Site no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
