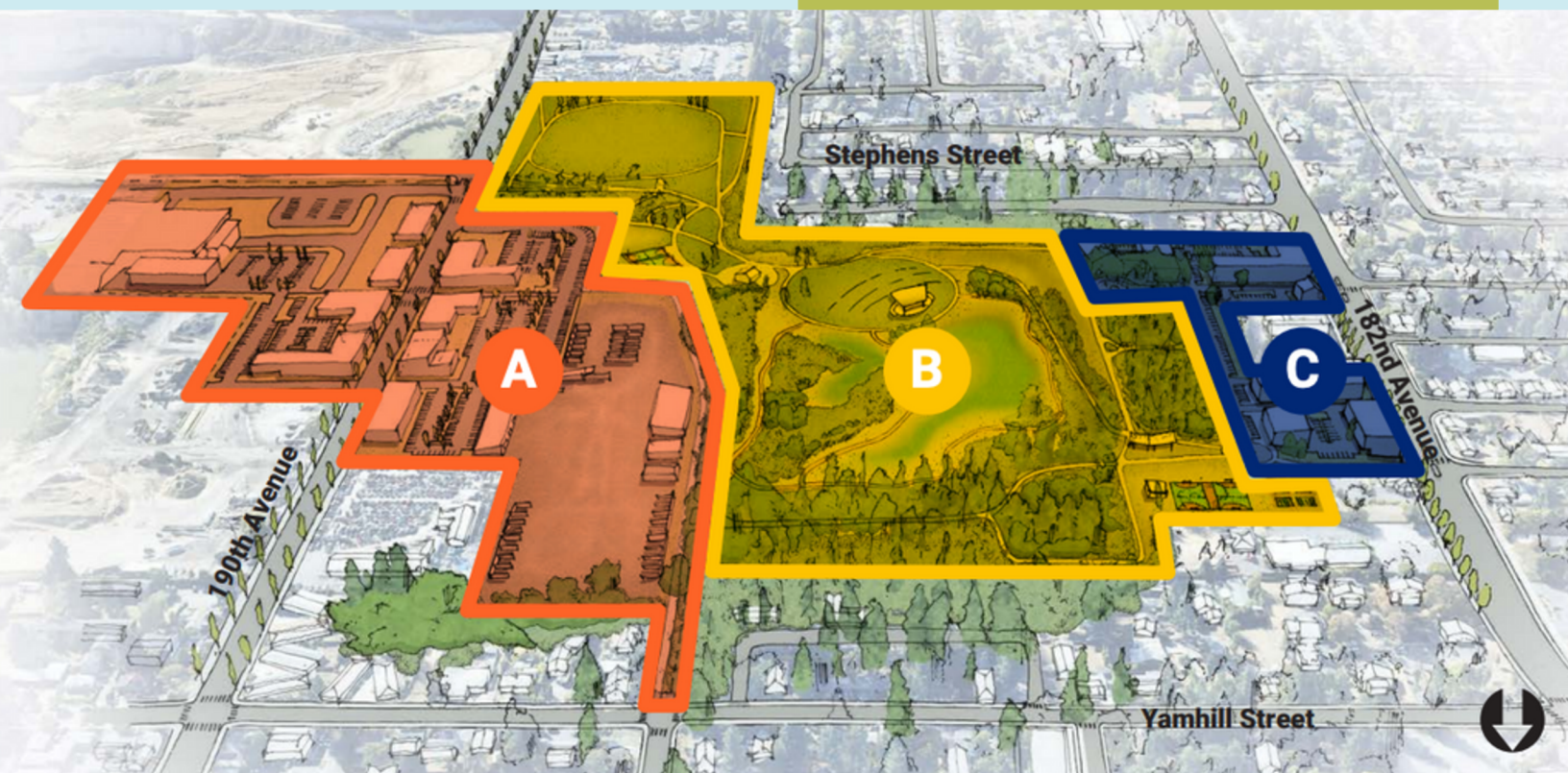
Reimagining over 40 acres of open space in Rockwood
