Multnomah County Veterans Service Officers are here to advocate, assist, and navigate veterans and their families with federal benefits they may be entitled to.

# Our role as a County Veterans' Services Officer?

The County Veterans' Services Office should be the first stop for all recently discharged Service members and anyone who has served in any of our Armed Forces branches to receive a complete benefit explanation. A VSO will ensure that Veterans and their families receive all state and federal benefits available to them.

VSOs are trained and accredited by the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs to represent Veterans in their claims for benefits.
