Thank you for allowing me to serve as your board member for the past four years.

After joining the board I discovered our school was not accredited, and I championed for that to change: talking with the Superintendent, holding community meetings and discussion at the Grange with the NWAC, and encouraging Corbett residents to let the District know Accreditation is important. Corbett is once again an accredited High School, and that is a benefit to our students

Parents told me they believed we should have a School Resource Officer in Corbett. I met with Sheriff Staton to help put a plan together to present to CSD. With the assistance of the Sheriff's Department and the Forest Service, Corbett Schools are now able to have this resource for 1/3 of the cost, verses if they had to fund an officer by themselves. I feel these partnerships are valuable.

I have attended OSBA training conferences, earning the Bronze, Silver and Gold certificates in Board Leadership. I am currently taking additional training in Salem to continue my school board education. Why? Because every child and every community member deserves an educated school board.

Community involvement with our schools is very important to me, as is an open and transparent school district. To encourage these: I have asked for committee meetings to fall under public meeting laws so all interested parties can attend, requested reports and information be posted to the school website for all to access, and have requested numerous times that we gather input from the community prior to making big decisions that affect not only students, but their families and this community.

I am asking for your vote so I may continue advocating for Corbett and our children.
