**OUR VISION**

As set forth by the School-Age Services Task Force, the optimal SUN Service System is one that:

*realizes the potential of those served through **inclusive access** to an **array of effective services** delivered through a **collaborative approach** and **integrated** across agencies, jurisdictions, and funders.*

**DISCUSSION POINTS**

***“inclusive access”*** means:

- All schools, all children;
- Every neighborhood in Multnomah County has an easily accessible way for children and families to connect with the services that they need;
- We build incrementally based on need;
- The system addresses risk factors; and
- The system created is adaptable.

***“integrated”*** means:

- The system is comprised of multiple streams of funding and resources;
- Organizations and groups transform current individual resources into shared system resources;
- The system is used as a mechanism for delivery of current and new services; and
- Multiple systems are organized and aligned to be more effective and efficient.
