Resources for People in Need

- For help in a life-threatening emergency, call 911
- For non-emergency help for someone experiencing a mental health crisis, call 911 and ask for Portland Street Response
- When someone is experiencing a mental health crisis, call Multnomah County Behavioral Health Call Center: 503-988-4888 (Project Respond mobile crisis services are available through this number.)
- For domestic violence or sexual assault help, call the Call to Safety crisis line: 888-235-5333 or visit calltosafety.org (formerly Portland Women's Crisis Line)
- For help finding shelter, call 211
