Adopting the 2026-27 Budget for the Mid-Multnomah County Street Lighting Service District No. 14 and Making Appropriations

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Mid-Multnomah County Street Lighting Service District No. 14 (District) Budget (District's Budget), attached and identified as Exhibit A, was prepared by the District's Budget Officer and has been considered and approved by the District's Budget Committee.
- b. Further, the District's Budget has been certified by the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission (Commission) in compliance with State law with no objections or recommendations, as verified by a letter dated **June 5, 2025**, from Allegra Willhite, the Executive Director of the Commission to the District, a copy of which is attached and identified as Exhibit B.
- c. The Budget as certified is on file in the Budget Office of Multnomah County.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. The District's Budget attached as Exhibit A is adopted as the budget of Mid-Multnomah County Street Lighting Service District No. 14, Oregon, in the amount of \$1,800,000.
2. The following appropriations are authorized for the fiscal year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027:
